Call for Poster Abstracts

Thank you for your interest in submitting an abstract for a poster presentation at the 2026 Integrative Aesthetics Summit (IAS). Please review the following information carefully before submitting.

The IAS abstract review committee welcomes a broad range of abstracts on topics related to medical aesthetics, skin health, and aesthetic treatments. The Committee will accept methodological research on the development and assessment of research approaches that help bridge gaps between conventional and integrative aesthetic practices. Submissions may cover a wide range of topics in aesthetics, including but not limited to the following areas:

- Acne and Acne Scarring
- Aesthetic Dermatology
- Injectables (Neurotoxins, Fillers, Biostimulants)
- Energy-Based Devices (Lasers, RF, Ultrasound)
- Anti-Aging and Longevity
- Skin Rejuvenation
- Diet and Nutrition
- Hair Restoration
- Herbals and Supplements
- Melasma and Pigmentation
- Mindfulness and Stress

- Naturopathy and Integrative Aesthetics
- Rosacea, Skin Cancer, and Aesthetic Considerations
- Skin of Color in Aesthetics
- Sun Protection and Photoaging
- Traditional Chinese Medicine
- Regenerative Aesthetics (PRP, Exosomes)
- Weight Loss (GLP-1) and Aesthetic Outcomes

Submission Types

You may submit one of the following:

1. Research Abstract

Original research related to dermatology or integrative medicine, including clinical, translational, or methodological research.

2. Clinical Case Study

Case-based submissions highlighting clinical presentation, integrative treatment approaches, and patient outcomes.

Review Process

Submissions received by June 19, 2026, will be reviewed by the IAS Review Committee. The Committee will make selections based on content, objectives, relevance, significance, originality, and clarity. Clinical case studies will be judged based on novelty and overall contribution to the field of integrative aesthetics. All applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision no later than July 6, 2026

Only one (1) submission may be presented by the same presenting author at the Integrative Dermatology Symposium. However, presenters may co-author multiple submissions. All submissions must be original and must not have been previously published or presented prior to submission to IAS. Simultaneous submission of the same work to other meetings is not permitted.

The following components must be included in your submission:

1. IAS Online Submission Form
2. Submission Content (Research Abstract or Case Study; see formatting guidelines below)
3. Headshot
4. Author biography and contact details

Formatting Guidelines

Word Limit: 500 words total which includes: The title, authors, institutions, and abstract body

Research Abstract Format

1. Background / Objective
2. Methods
3. Results
4. Conclusion
5. Key Takeaways

Case Study Format

1. Background / Clinical Context
2. Patient Presentation
3. Diagnosis and Workup
4. Treatment Approach
5. Outcomes
6. Clinical Insights / Key Takeaways

Poster Presentation Requirements

Presenters must attend IAS in person.

Poster Specifications

- Final posters should be no more than 24" tall by 36" wide
- Posters may be prepared in the format of a single large poster made in PowerPoint, which can be enlarged and printed by a photocopy store or university printing shop to the specified size. Please check with the store that will print your poster to determine the specifications of your PowerPoint slide for the proper enlargement
- All shipping to/from the conference will be at the expense of the author(s)
- At least one author is expected to present their poster during the poster session at the IAS.
- Please make sure your poster is well laid out and clear.
